WHAT WE’RE LEARNING:

- English:** Narratives: We’re Going on a Bear Hunt and Three Billy Goats Gruff
- Maths:** EYFS - Counting larger groups, tens frames and rekenreks. Y1 - Time: O’clock and half past.
- Science:** Growing: How seeds grow into larger plants and basic parts of a plant and tree.
- Geography:** Which plants grow in different parts of the world?
- PE:** Rounders, cricket and athletics.
