WHAT WE'RE LEARNING:

English: Drawing Club using the prompts 'Stuck' by Oliver Jeffers and 'Bananaman'

Maths: Y1 - Introducing multiplication and division, R - Odds, evens, doubles, halves and sharing Art: Portraits - Van Gogh, Klee and Picasso. Exploring mixed media to create our own portraits. Music: Our favourite music - please ask your children to let us know their favourite songs to sing

along to.
