WHAT WE ARE LEARNING:

English: Yr R - Writing words, captions and simple sentences. Yr 1 - Using 'and' to join sentences and using adjectives to describe.

Class Books - *The Hare and the Tortoise*, *If I Had a Dinosaur*, *Little People Big Dreams - Mary Anning*

Maths: YR - Exploring the composition of numbers; practical adding and taking away.

Yr 1 - Using number lines; ordering and comparing numbers; doubles; and number bonds.

Discover: Mary Anning and Mary/Gideon Mantell. Understanding that dinosaurs lived before people.

Explore: New Year/Lunar New Year; land geography: volcanoes & cliffs.

Create: Sculpture using different media: salt dough fossils.

Phonics: Yr R - Read and write simple words; recognise some tricky words with quick recall.

Yr 1 - Digraphs and trigraphs; reading words with consonant blends.

Science: Signs of season changes; animals that live in hot and cold places.

PE: Gymnastics - Ball skills and gymnastics.

RE: Christianity - Creation Story; Judaism and Islam - God as the Creator of Life.

PSHE: Relationships -Wellbeing: Express Yourself, Thought Gremlins, Values, Gratitude, Challenges.
